



Fen Ditton Community Primary School Local Governing Body (LGB) Update – October 2022

Dear Parents,

It has taken a little longer to get this update to you than I had originally planned, but in the delay, it does allows me to provide an update after our first two meetings of this Academic year.

To all new parents at Fen Ditton, welcome to you. The Governing Body are thrilled that you have chosen Fen Ditton and we hope you and your children will be very happy during your time with us.

Governor Matters

As mentioned, we have had two meetings so far this year – the first a full meeting, and the second an opportunity to review the Academy Improvement Plan for the year and agree how we as a Governing Body will monitor the progress of delivering this. We also spent a bit of time thinking about how we will build on the work done last year regarding the vision for the school for the next 3-5 years – more on that a little later.

The cycle of Governors finishing, and recruiting new Governors continues. We have been very fortunate in the recruitment process over the summer and have been able to welcome two new Trust Appointed Governors to join our LGB team. Firstly, Lyndsay Davies, a resident in Horningsea and secondly, Paula Bishop, a resident of Fen Ditton. As I mentioned at the end of last year, two of our Parent Governors have finished their terms and we wish to put on record our thanks to them for the 4 years they have served – Steve Dawson and Layla Skinns. Layla, as our Safeguarding governor for the past few years, has agreed to stay with us until Christmas to enable a hand over.

We therefore have a vacancy for a Parent Governor, and we are thrilled to report that Miriam Ferrer has been appointed, having served for a year as an Associate Governor, joining Chris Lindley as a Parent Governor.

As a result of changes to the structure of the LGB introduced by Anglian Learning, Miss Clough is also stepping down as a Staff Governor, leaving Mrs Tabram as the remaining Staff Governor. Again, we wish to put on record our thanks to Miss Clough – we are very aware that on meeting nights staff are often still at school well after 8pm (even though our meetings are quite efficient and don't run on, I hasten to add!!), so it does make for long days for them.

We do still have one vacancy and we can have another Associate Governor, so if there are any parents who would be interested in joining the Governing Body, do get in touch and I'd love the opportunity to chat about our work and role.
