School Uniform Dress Code

The uniform consists of:

- Navy sweatshirt /cardigan available with the school logo
- Plain navy or white polo shirt (green for Year 6), available with the school logo
- White blouse or a white shirt
- Grey skirt/pinafore dress or grey trousers
- Dark shoes or dark trainers (no shoes without backs or high heels)

For warmer weather:

- Grey tailored shorts or skirt
- Blue and white striped or gingham dress
- Navy or white polo shirt (green for Year 6)
- Sandals (socks must be worn)

For PE lessons all children should have:

- A navy T Shirt, navy shorts and indoor trainers or plimsolls all in a bag
- Outdoor PE trainers and a tracksuit for colder weather

Please note: Cambridge LA now insist that all jewellery, including ear studs be removed for PE lessons. It will be the pupils' responsibility to remove their own ear studs for their PE lessons.

The following items are not part of the school dress code and should not be worn:

- Hooded tops, jogging bottoms with stripes or logos, non school logo T shirts
- Jewellery –we ask that you do not allow your children to come to school wearing jewellery (other than that worn for religious observance) as this can present a risk of injury, particularly during PE sessions and break times. All jewellery must be removed for PE lessons. Earrings can be worn to school and these should be small silver or gold studs.
- No make up or nail varnish should be worn to school

Parents with a child with possible sensory needs should contact the SENCO to discuss appropriate uniform adjustments.
