REMINDER: WE ARE A NUT FREE SCHOOL: Can we please remind you we are a nut free school. Children who suffer from nut allergies can develop a severe, potentially life-threatening allergic reaction. If someone has a nut allergy it is not just eating nuts that can cause a severe reaction, just being touched on the skin or smelling the breath of someone who has had nuts or a product containing nuts can trigger anaphylactic shock (which can cause breathing and swallowing difficulties).

We cannot have nuts in school, in any form.

So, please can we ask that you do not send your child into school with nut products or anything that may contain nuts. For example, some chocolate spreads, biscuits, granola, or cereal bars.

Please check the packaging on foods that you use for your child's lunches and snacks.

Thank you for helping us to keep all children safe in our school.
