#### **School Reports**

Once you have dropped your child off, please come and collect your child's report as you leave.

From Monday 15th July the reports will be available to collect from the school office.

Please complete the reply slip in the reports and return them to school via your child's class teacher, the office or a member of SLT on the gate by Friday 19th July.

#### **Free School Meals Eligibility**

All families are encouraged to check eligibility for free school meals even if you do not think you would qualify at this point. This can be done by completing the attached application form, once completed the Education Welfare Benefit Team will be able to continually check eligibility throughout your child's school years using the ECS checking system. You would then be notified if you become eligible in the future.

Please Note: For pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 who automatically receive Universal Infant Free School Meals must also complete this form.

Parents with children already in receipt of Free School Meals do not need to fill in the application form again.

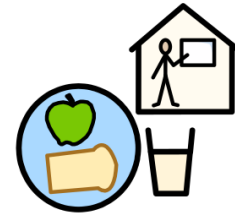
## School Meal Ordering System

### The 68th Horningsea Horticultural Show: Saturday, 13th July in Village Hall






