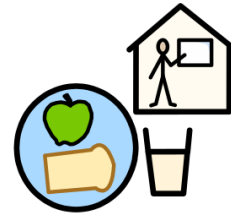
## School Meal Ordering System

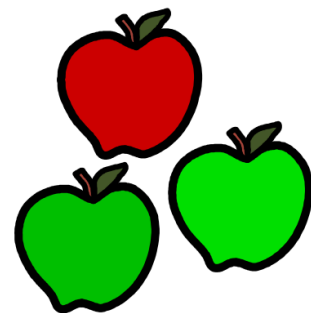


**Apple Pressing Day 2024! Saturday, 28th September, 14:00 - Village Green**
